

## Environmental Policy

The company has formalized its own Environmental Policy:

Meccanoplastica, aware of its role in the industrial and regional context and of the contribution that manufacturing companies can make to sustainable development, defines this Environmental Policy in line with its corporate strategy, taking into account the internal and external context, relevant stakeholders, and the risks and opportunities associated with its activities, products, and services.

The company recognizes that environmental protection, sustainable resource management, and reduced environmental impact are fundamental elements of competitiveness and social responsibility.

Therefore, it is committed to conducting all its activities in compliance with applicable laws, environmental regulations, and the principles of continuous performance improvement, adopting an integrated approach based on the life cycle assessment of its processes and products.

In particular, Meccanoplastica is committed to:

- **Ensure compliance** with all legislative, regulatory, and other environmental requirements, continuously monitoring regulatory developments.
- **Prevent and reduce environmental impacts** from its operations through the adoption of efficient technologies, sustainable operating practices, and the control of emissions, energy consumption, and waste generation.
- **Protect the environment** in the broadest sense, including pollution prevention, sustainable use of natural resources, mitigation and adaptation to climate change, and the protection of biodiversity and ecosystems.
- **Manage environmental risks and opportunities** by identifying significant environmental aspects and implementing preventive and corrective measures to reduce the likelihood and severity of undesirable impacts.
- **Integrate a life cycle perspective** into the design, procurement, and manufacturing of its products, promoting the reduction of impacts along the entire value chain, up to the end of the equipment's life.
- **Optimize energy consumption** and increase the share of energy from renewable sources.
- **Promote proper waste management**, the recovery of recyclable fractions, and the reduction of production waste.
- **Ensure the environmental safety** of plants and production activities by preventing accidents, spills, or uncontrolled emissions through appropriate structural and management measures.
- **Raise awareness and train personnel** at all levels, so that each understands their roles and responsibilities in environmental management and actively contributes to improving performance.
- **Communicate transparently** with stakeholders, competent authorities, and the community, disseminating information on environmental policies and performance through digital tools and official channels.
- **Establish and periodically review measurable environmental objectives and targets** consistent with the company's strategic guidelines, verifying their implementation through environmental performance indicators.
